A Cantonese wedding can look quite different from a Shanghainese one, and an overseas Chinese family may blend traditions in ways that surprise relatives in China. This bundle presents common practices, not universal rules. The most important thing is to communicate openly with both families and make choices that feel authentic to you as a couple.
